Juli 1905 im

damaligen Rustschuk heute Russe Bulgarien geboren und starb am 14 August 1994 in Zürich. Er stammt aus einer jüdischen Familie, deren Vorfahren aus Spanien vertrieben worden waren. 1911 kam es zum Umzug der Familie nach Manchester. Nach dem Tod des Vaters siedelten die Canettis nach Wien um. Aufgrund des Kriegspatriotismus der Österreicher blieben sie aber auch dort nicht lange wohnhaft, sondern zogen 1916 in die Schweiz. Dort lebten sie schließlich fünf Jahre lang, ehe 1921 der Umzug nach Deutschland erfolgte. Von 1924 bis 1929 studierte E. Canetti Chemie in Wien. Sein wirkliches Interesse galt aber der Literatur. In dieser Zeit besuchte er regelmäßig die Lesungen von Karl Kraus. Ebenfalls in diese Zeitspanne fällt auch seine erste Beschäftigung mit dem sozialpsychologischen Phänomen der Masse, dessen Erforschung Canetti sein Leben widmete. In seinem zweiten Band *Die Fackel im Ohr*, welcher erst 1980 veröffentlicht wurde, beschreibt er ein Stück seiner Lebensgeschichte, das sich auf eben diese Zeit 1921 bis 1931 bezieht und somit wichtige Anhaltspunkte für seine Auseinandersetzung mit Masse liefert. Abgesehen von Karl Kraus setzt sich Canetti mit Freuds Massenpsychologie und Ich-Analyse auseinander und erlebt die Auswirkungen von Masse an der eigenen Person, wobei der 15. 07. 1927 diesbezüglich für ihn zum wichtigsten Tag wird. Die Erlebnisse, die Canetti am meisten geprägt haben sollen, sind in den folgenden Kapiteln näher beleuchtet, um den Weg zu seinem 1960 erschienenen theoretischen Hauptwerk *Masse und Macht*, an welchem er fast zwanzig Jahre lang gearbeitet hat, zu verdeutlichen.
