and their bearing on the aesthetic facet of his commitment to the art of poetry which come forward most poignantly in his poetry of pastoral or Wordsworthian content These three major facets of Bly's commitment to his art are shown to be observable in specific poems and to combine in unique configurations of meaning The thesis is the only existing study of Robert Bly's recent work and devotes a great deal more thought to his prose poetry than other studies on Bly's work Moreover the thesis provides a framework that other critics may find useful in dealing with a body of poetry that resists critical analysis yet continues to assert a considerable influence upon contemporary developments in American poetry
