Hitler's Prisons - Legal Terror in Nazi Germany Nikolaus Wachsmann, 2015-05-26 State prisons played an indispensable part in the terror of the Third Reich incarcerating many hundreds of thousands of men and women during the Nazi era This important book illuminates the previously unknown world of Nazi prisons their victims and the judicial and penal officials who built and operated this system of brutal legal terror Nikolaus Wachsmann describes the operation and function of legal terror in the Third Reich and brings Nazi prisons to life through the harrowing stories of individual inmates Drawing on a vast array of archival materials he traces the series of changes in prison policies and practice that led eventually to racial terror brutal violence slave labor starvation and mass killings Wachsmann demonstrates that ordinary legal officials were ready collaborators who helped to turn courts and prisons into key components in the Nazi web of terror And he concludes with a discussion of the whitewash of the Nazi legal system in postwar West Germany

The Order of Terror Wolfgang Sofsky, 2013-06-17 During the twelve years from 1933 until 1945 the concentration camp operated as a terror society In this pioneering book the renowned German sociologist Wolfgang Sofsky looks at the concentration camp from the inside as a laboratory of cruelty and a system of absolute power built on extreme violence starvation terror labor and the business like extermination of human beings Based on historical documents and the reports of survivors the book details how the resistance of prisoners was broken down Arbitrary terror and routine violence destroyed personal identity and social solidarity disrupted the very ideas of time and space perverted human work into torture and unleashed innumerable atrocities As a result daily life was reduced to a permanent struggle for survival even as the meaning of self preservation was extinguished Sofsky takes us from the searing unforgettable image of the Muselmann Auschwitz jargon for the walking dead to chronicles of epidemics terror punishments selections and torture The society of the camp was

dominated by the S S and a system of graduated and forced collaboration which turned selected victims into accomplices of terror Sofsky shows that the S S was not a rigid bureaucracy but a system with ample room for autonomy The S S demanded individual initiative of its members Consequently although they were not required to torment or murder prisoners officers and guards often exploited their freedom to do so in passing or on a whim with cause or without The order of terror described by Sofsky culminated in the organized murder of millions of European Jews and Gypsies in the death factories of Auschwitz and Treblinka By the end of this book Sofsky shows that the German concentration camp system cannot be seen as a temporary lapse into barbarism Instead it must be conceived as a product of modern civilization where institutionalized state run human cruelty became possible with or without the mobilizing feelings of hatred

The Nazi Concentration Camps, 1933-1939 Christian Goeschel, Nikolaus Wachsmann, 2012-07-01 Weeks after Adolf Hitler came to power in 1933 the Nazi regime established the first concentration camps in Germany Initially used for real and suspected political enemies the camps increasingly came under SS control and became sites for the repression of social outsiders and German Jews Terror was central to the Nazi regime from the beginning and the camps gradually moved toward the center of repression torture and mass murder during World War II and the Holocaust This collection brings together revealing primary documents on the crucial origins of the Nazi concentration camp system in the prewar years between 1933 and 1939 which have been overlooked thus far Many of the documents are unpublished and have been translated into English for the first time These documents provide insight into the camps from multiple perspectives including those of prisoners Nazi officials and foreign observers and shed light on the complex relationship between terror state and society in the Third Reich

The Women's Camp in Moringen Gabriele Herz, 2006 The Nazi regime opened its first concentration camps within weeks of coming to power but with the exception of Dachau the history of these early improvised camps and their inmates is not yet widely known Gabriele Herz's memoir published for the first time is a unique record of a Jewish woman's detention in the first women's concentration camp in Moringen housed in part of an old established workhouse at a time when most other inmates were communists or Jehovah's Witnesses This original translation of her wry and perceptive memoir is accompanied by an extensive introduction that sets Herz's experience in the history both of political detention under the Nazi regime and of the German workhouse system Publisher's website

Builders of the Third Reich Charles Dick, 2020-11-12 This is the first comprehensive critical study of the Organisation Todt OT a key institution which oversaw the Third Reich's vast slave labour programme together with the SS Wehrmacht and industry The book breaks new ground by revealing the full extent of the organisation's brutal and murderous operations across occupied Europe and in the Reich For the first time Charles Dick provides a strong voice for camp survivors overseen by the OT drawing on an extensive collection of personal accounts and analysing the violence they endured Builders of the Third Reich shows Hitler used the OT which had a labour force of around 1.5 million people in 1944 as an instrument of subjugation and occupation to project German imperial power Drawing on a broad range of primary sources it demonstrates how the organisation participated in the plunder of Europe's raw materials and manpower greatly boosting the German war economy The book reveals how OT staff shot beat or worked tens of thousands of prisoners to death both within the SS-run concentration camp system and outside it with analysis of OT operations showing that where it had sole or very high levels of control over camps prisoner death rates were extremely high Examining how engineers and builders individuals who fitted the category of ordinary men as precisely as any other group so far examined by historians perpetrated war crimes this volume reflects on how few OT personnel were interrogated or came to trial and how the organisation passed largely under the radar of post-war prosecutors researchers and the general public

Zur Beantwortung der komplexen Fragestellung nach selbständigen Tendenzen müssen die Bedingungen des Außenlagers im Einzelnen betrachtet werden. Die Lebens- und Arbeitsbedingungen der Häftlinge können nicht nur durch Beschreibung der Zustände nachvollzogen werden, sondern deren Ursachen und Folgen sowie die Veränderungen sind zu unterscheiden. Es stellt sich daher die Frage, wie die spezifischen Existenzbedingungen entstehen und inwieweit dabei der Einfluss des Stammlagers greift. Den Schwerpunkt der Betrachtung des Außenlagers Rottleberode bilden die Lebensbedingungen der Häftlinge, deren Leiden allerdings im Rahmen der Arbeit nicht beschrieben werden können. Monsters exist but they are too few in number to be truly dangerous. More dangerous are the common men, the functionaries ready to believe and to act without asking questions. Lewy concludes that the perpetrators acted out of a variety of motives: a sense of duty, obedience to authority, thirst for career, and a blind faith in anti-Semitic ideology, among others. A witness to the 1938 Kristallnacht himself and the son of a concentration camp survivor, Lewy has searched for the reasons of the Holocaust out of far more than theoretical interest; it is a passionate attempt to illuminate a dismal chapter of his life and of human history that cannot be forgotten.
