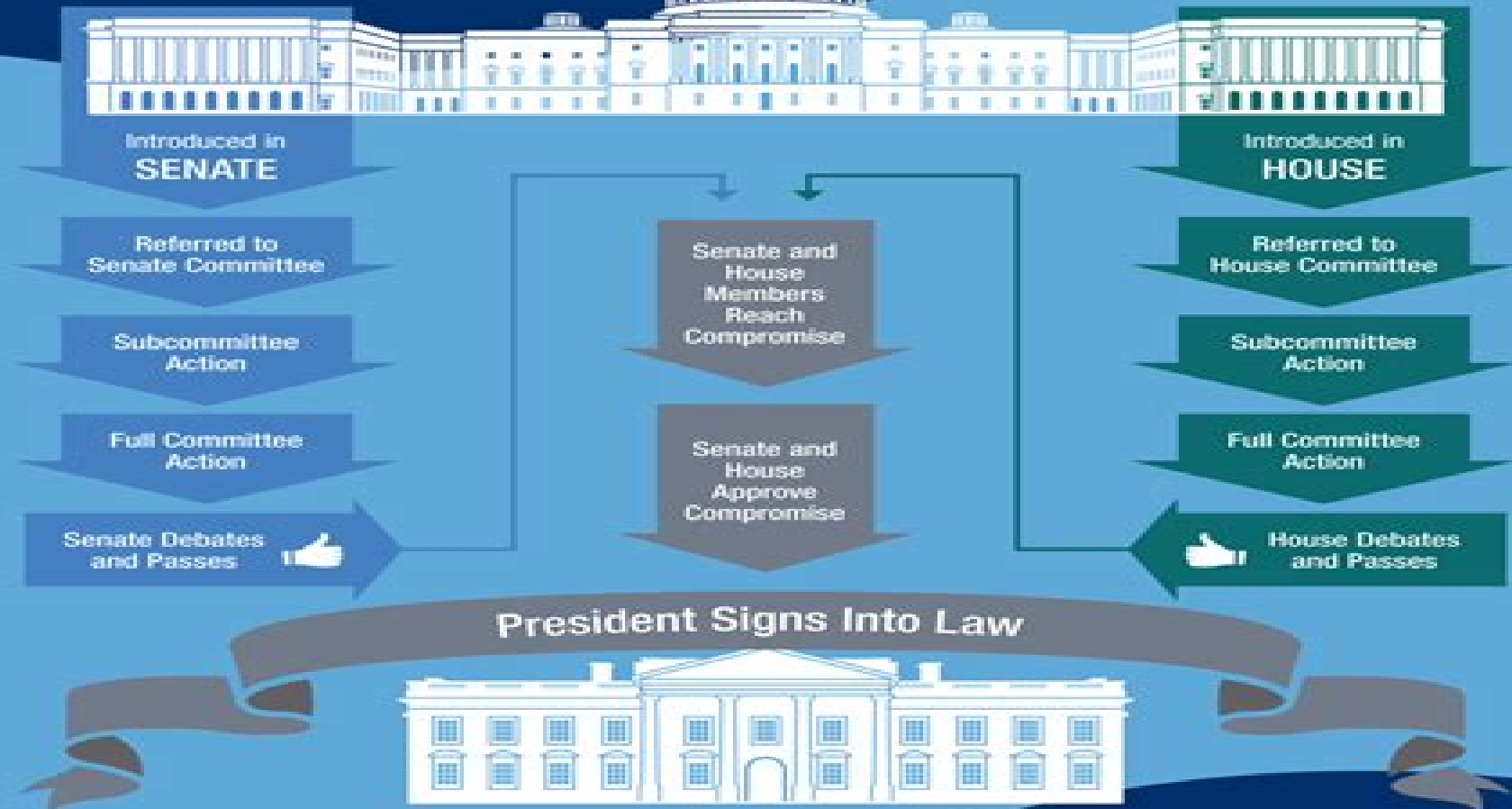


How the Legislative Process Works
