Reflecting on almost three decades of postsocialist transformations the second edition of *Globalization on the Margins* explores continuities and changes in Central Asian education development since the dissolution of the Soviet Union in 1991 with a particular focus on the developments that took place since the production of the first edition in 2011. Rather than viewing these transformations in isolation the authors place their analyses within the global context by reflecting on the interaction between Soviet legacies and global education reform pressures in the Central Asian countries of Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan. This new edition in addition to a revised introduction and a newly added conclusion consists of four thematic sections each reflecting a key theme in the educational life of the Central Asian states.
