Dresden had become a city transformed by the pressures of total war its population swollen far beyond normal capacity by refugees fleeing the advancing Soviet forces in the east Estimates suggest that the city's peacetime population of approximately 630 000 had grown to perhaps 1.2 million people including hundreds of thousands of civilians who had abandoned their homes in East Prussia Silesia and other eastern territories now occupied by the Red Army These refugees many traveling with nothing more than what they could carry had overwhelmed Dresden's capacity to provide shelter food and basic services creating humanitarian conditions that were dire even by wartime standards
