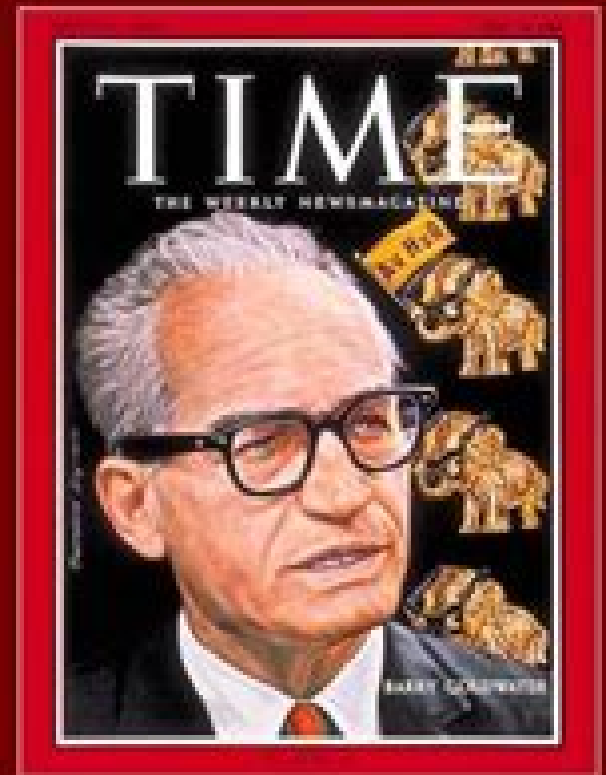


# The Conservative Movement
