

Constitutional reform in the UK

- For many years constitutional reform has been **dismissed** for being **un-British**, but since the **Blair government (1997)**, constitutional reform has become **significant**. These reforms have sought to introduce the following:
 - **Modernisation** - the constitution became out of date and out of line with the rest of Europe. Thus, referendums were given to bring about a wide range of constitutional reforms.
 - **Democratisation** - influenced by liberalism with the aim of making the constitution more democratic. E.g. Lords reform.
 - **Decentralisation** - fragmenting power by transferring it from central government to regional bodies. E.g. Scottish parliament.
 - **Stronger protection of rights** - an enhanced protection of rights was introduced with the incorporation of EU laws and FOI act 2000.

Constitutional reforms by New Labour 1997 - 2010

- New Labour was run by **Blair** from 1997-2007 and then by **Brown** from 2007-2010. The **Blair government** passed the **most radical reform** to the UK constitution in the 20th century.



Reform	Explanation
	Considerable power from central government was transferred to a Scottish parliament and Welsh assembly in 1999 , following a referendum . This process is known as devolution , which is a process of transferring power from the Parliament and government to regional governments in Scotland and Wales .
