

perspective In a series of eight experiments involving surveys email generation email and listserv post interpretation and transcription participants indicate that nonverbal cues are closely intertwined in meaning to verbal cues that is the type of nonverbal cue being used carries specific interpretations and the verbal content of the message allows a reader to choose from among the possible implications Nonverbal cues are principally used to signal emotion and emphasize verbal content and are strongly related to prosody in speech The communication goals that nonverbal cues fulfill are strongly related to their semiotic group However there is a discrepancy between what the writer intends when using nonverbal cues and what the reader interprets upon seeing the nonverbal cues These results are discussed in the context of several assumptions about nonverbal cues made in prior research including that of research on emoticons and additive effects of nonverbal cues
