1/ Arthritis

Joint deformity, stiffness, and restricted range of motion are all symptoms of arthritis.

It also causes pain and swelling in joints.

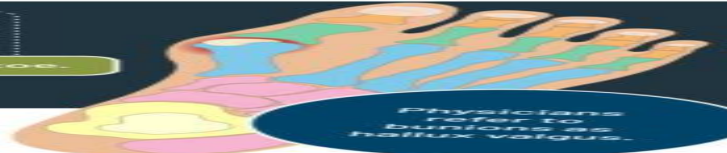
Arthritis can cause the cartilage to degenerate to the point to scrape against one another.

Arthritis in the foot causes severe pain.

2/ Bunions

Bunions are bony bumps that develop at the base of the big toe joint.

It may cause a little inward bend of the big toe.



Physicians refer to bunions as *hallux valgus*.

They can develop as a result of wearing narrow or tight shoes.

Bunions are more common in women, but can occur from narrow shoes.

3/ Hammertoes

A hammertoe happens when your second, third, or fourth toe is bent in the middle of the toe joint, crossed, or simply pointed in an unusual direction.

It can develop wearing shoes that are too tight.

Your doctor may recommend wearing comfortable shoes.



Your toe can also be repositioned by using inserts or foot pads.

4/ Gout

A buildup of uric acid in the body causes gout.

It usually affects your big toe but can also affect other joints.



It's characterized by sudden, intense bouts of joint pain, swelling, redness, and tenderness.

Ankle, knee, elbow, and finger joints are commonly impacted.

It's important to consult a podiatrist or orthopedic specialist if you experience consistent foot discomfort, redness, or swelling.
