latter was reviewed by the young Søren Kierkegaard After a visit to Sweden in 1837 Andersen became inspired by Scandinavism and committed himself to writing a poem that would convey the relatedness of Swedes Danes and Norwegians It was in July 1839 during a visit to the island of Funen that Andersen first wrote the text of his poem Jeg er en Skandinav I am a Scandinavian Andersen composed the poem to capture the beauty of the Nordic spirit the way the three sister nations have gradually grown together as part of a Scandinavian national anthem Composer Otto Lindblad set the poem to music and the composition was published in January 1840 Its popularity peaked in 1845 after which it was seldom sung Andersen spent two weeks at the Augustenborg Palace in the autumn of 1844 Fairy Tales from Hans Christian Andersen.
