Talking a closer look Point Counter Point reveals Huxley's belief in a deeper truth that remains mysterious in its contingent

existence of absence and presence In connection with Huxley's understanding of God which he lays down mainly in his book. The Perennial Philosophy 1945 Huxley's representation of evilness alias Spandrell is going to be analysed in this paper 8. There are other characters in Point Counter Point concerned with the question of God for example Marjorie Carling 9. However the focus will be on Spandrell as the contemplations about good and evil concentrate around his character. Spandrell constantly tries to explain God's absence and make his presence felt but he is disappointed again and again In this way he embodies the focal point of the problem of evil in Point Counter Point The root of evil in Spandrell's case can be found in his individual psychology. With the help of Spandrell Huxley reflects on the origin of evil in particular on how evilness can develop in a person's life.
