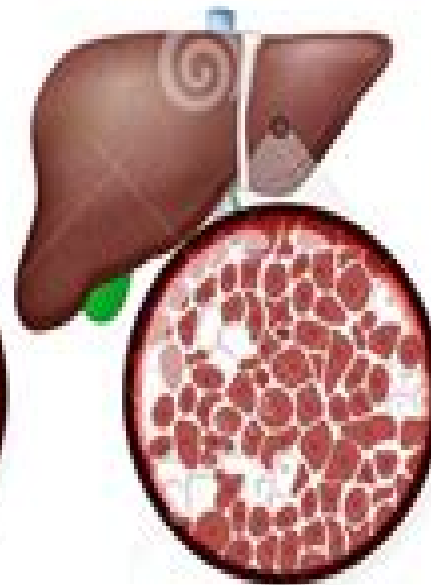

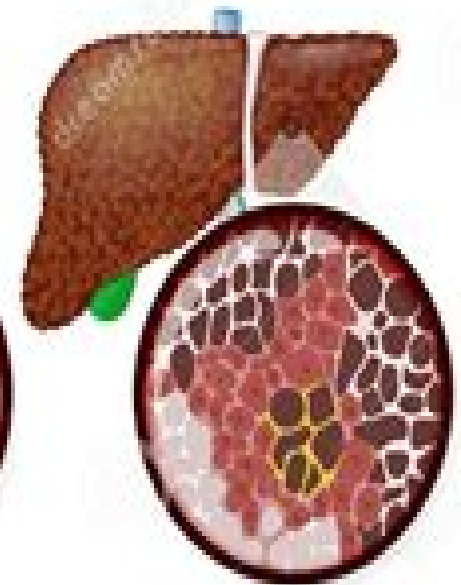
Excess fat builds
