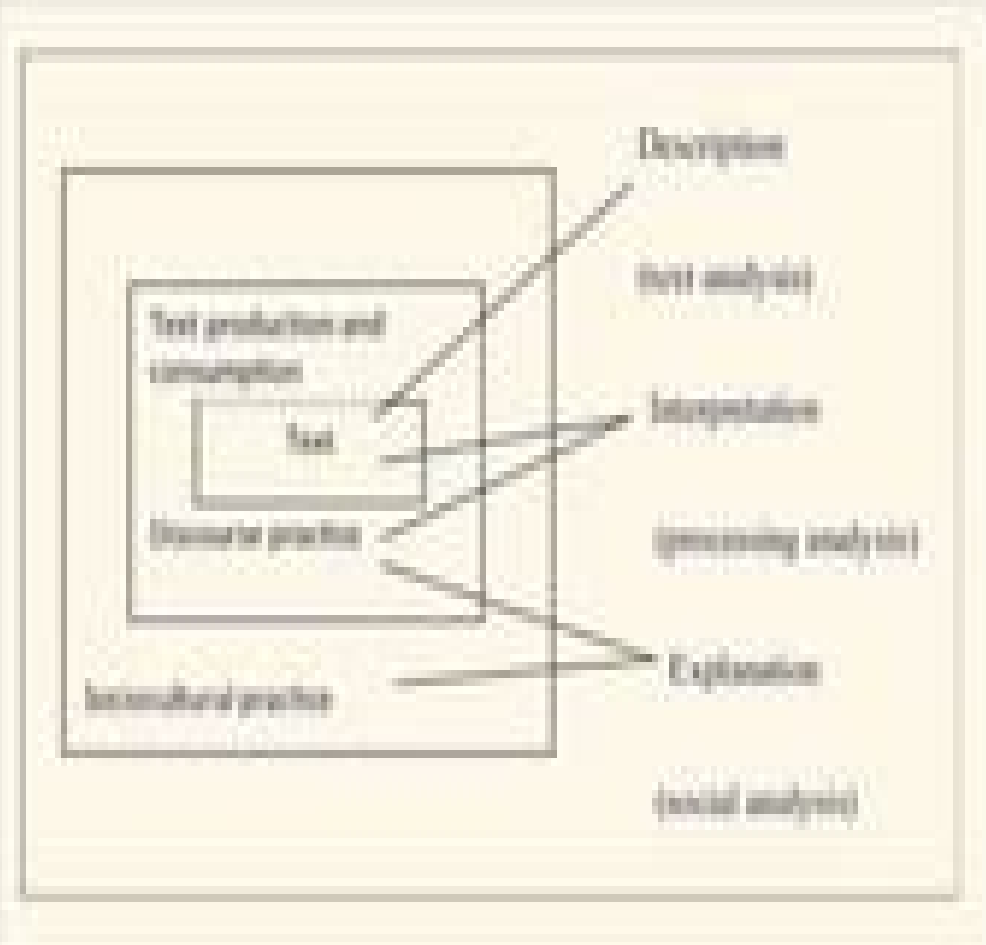


Discursive Practice
