The book demonstrates how adolescents make use of assistance provided by social support systems and points to the changing influence of parents and peers It addresses controversial issues such as benefits and costs of close relationships or the beneficial or maladaptive effects of avoidant coping Its clear style innovative ideas and instruments make it an excellent
