they mattered to O Connor It also acts as a window to the writer's experiences in the city whether she was coming into town for a series of meetings or strolling down Broadway on her way to lunch In the end it is the combination of the who she knew and the what she did that formed O Connor's personal view of what is arguably the most famous of American cities
