**Descent Into Discourse** Bryan D. Palmer, 1990-01 Critical theory is no substitute for historical materialism language is not life With this statement Bryan Palmer enters the debate that is now transforming and disrupting a number of academic disciplines including political science women s studies and history Focusing on the ways in which literary or critical theory is being promoted within the field of social history he argues forcefully that the current reliance on poststructuralism with its reification of discourse and avoidance of the structures of oppression and struggles of resistance obscures the origins meanings and consequences of historical events and processes Palmer is concerned with the emergence of language as a central focus of intellectual work in the twentieth century He locates the implosion of theory that moved structuralism in the direction of poststructuralism and deconstruction in what he calls the descent into discourse Few historians who champion poststructuralist thought according to Palmer appreciate historical materialism's capacity to address discourse meaningfully Nor do many of the advocates of language within the field of social history have an adequate grounding in the theoretical making of the project they champion so ardently Palmer roots his polemical challenge in an effort to introduce historians more fully to the theoretical writing that many are alluding to and drawing from rather cavalierly Acknowledging that critical theory can contribute to an understanding of some aspects of the past Palmer nevertheless argues for the centrality of materialism to the project of history In specific discussions of how critical theory is constructing histories of politics class and gender he traces the development of the descent into discourse within social history mapping the limitations of recent revisionist texts Much of this writing he contends is undertheorized and represents a problematic retreat from prior histories that attempted to address such material forces as economic structures political power and class struggle Descent into Discourse counters current intellectual fashion with an eloquent argument for the necessity to analyze and appreciate lived experience and the structures of subordination and power in any quest for historical meaning Trials of Irish History Evi Gkotzaridis, 2013-04-15 Bringing her original insights into theory and philosophy to bear upon the controversial question of revision in Irish history Evi Gkotzaridis presents the first historical and theoretical examination of the trailblazer historians who from 1938 spearheaded an unpoliticized Irish history Drawing on hitherto unused archives Trials of Irish History shows how the venture to disenthrall Irish and European history from official propagandas proved stimulating and challenging but perilous Providing a new and stimulating conceptual framework for the study of Irish historiography the book combines a theoretical approach with close analysis of important case studies and includes an incisive restaging of the passionate joust that took place between revisionists and traditionalists in the shadow of the Troubles examination of the cultural contradiction of the first decades of independence the estrangement of two regimes and the devastation of the Second World War comparison of the Irish Kulturkampf to similar discussions in German and France in order to identify and examine the arguments propounded on each side Prising open conflicting intellectual notions about the function of history in a divided

Emmons, 2012-10-11 Convention has it that Irish immigrants in American experience the nineteenth century confined themselves mainly to industrial cities of the East and Midwest The truth is that Irish Catholics went everywhere in America and often had as much of a presence in the West as in the East In Beyond the American Pale David M Emmons examines this multifaceted experience of westering Irish and in doing so offers a fresh and discerning account of America's westward expansion Irish in the West is not a historical contradiction but it is and was a historical problem Irish Catholics were not supposed to be in the West that was where Protestant Americans went to reinvent themselves For many of the same reasons that the spread of southern slavery was thought to profane the West a Catholic presence there was thought to contradict it to contradict America's Protestant individualism and freedom The Catholic Irish were condemned as the clannish backward remnants of an old cultural world that Americans self consciously sought to leave behind The sons and daughters of Erin were not assimilated and because they were not assimilable they should be kept beyond the American pale As Emmons amply demonstrates however western reality was far more complicated Irish Catholicism may have outraged Protestant inspired American republicanism but Irish Catholics were a necessary component of America's equally Protestant inspired foray into industrial capitalism They were also necessary to the successive conquests of the frontier wherever it might be found It was the Irish who helped build the railroads dig the hard rocks man the army posts and do the other arduous dangerous and unattractive toiling required by an industrializing society With vigor and panache Emmons describes how the West was not so much won as continually contested and reshaped He probes the self fulfilling mythology of the American West along with the far different mythology of the Irish pioneers The product of three decades of research and thought Beyond the American Pale is a masterful yet accessible recasting of American history the culminating work of a singular thinker willing to take a wholly new perspective on the past The French Connection in Criminology Bruce A.
