## Who is René Descartes?

René Descartes (March 31, 1596 - February 11, 1650), a French mathematician, scientist, and philosopher, is known for his pivotal contributions to modern philosophy. He rejected traditional Scholastic Aristotelianism and introduced mind-body dualism, giving rise to the mind-body problem. He emphasized observation and experimentation as the foundation for a new science. Descartes famously declared "I think, therefore I am," as he built his epistemology on the certainty of self-awareness during thought. He proposed a metaphysical dualism, distinguishing mind as thinking and matter as extension in three dimensions. While his metaphysics relied on innate ideas, his physics and physiology were mechanistic and empirically grounded.
