Systems of ideas intended to explain design including the question of what is well designed and what is poorly designed.

Overview

- Design principles that capture a fundamental truth about design such as the idea that visual designs should look balanced.
- Techniques such as symmetrical balance or asymmetrical balance used to achieve designs.
- Theories that relate to design such as color theory.
- Concepts that explain different aspects of design such as the idea of color temperature whereby colors are perceived as being hot or cold.
- Ethics that guide the impact of designs in the real world such as *design to the edges*, the idea that designs be accessible for as many people as possible.
- Principles that apply to the design process such as *preserving ambiguity* that calls for delaying assumptions and leaving things open-ended for as long as possible.

Examples

1. Visual design principles such as visual balance.
2. Elements of design such as rhythm & repetition.
3. Design techniques such as asymmetrical balance.
4. Design philosophies such as *form follows function*.
5. Design methodologies such as user experience design.
6. Theories related to design such as color theory or human factors.
7. Usability principles such as least astonishment – the principle that designs be intuitive.
8. Aesthetics such as minimalism or traditional aesthetics.
9. Design ethics in areas such as social responsibility, environmental stewardship and accessibility.
10. Design processes such as throwaway prototypes or design charettes.
