COLORSPACE



Design in the CMYK color space to ensure your file prints as accurately as possible. If you are working in Photoshop, Design in the RGB color space and convert to CMYK when finished.

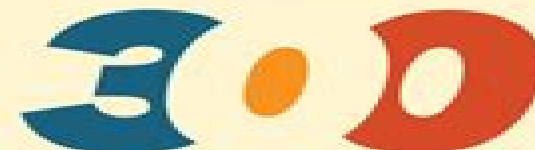

These are standard poster sizes in the US and Europe. Make sure before you start however, that you are designing in the correct dimensions for the application (transit shelter, etc.).

RESOLUTION



300 DPI (dots per inch)! No less.

Litho

A printer creates a set of 'plates' which are used to press the image onto paper. There are initial costs involved in creating the plates and setting up the press. This means a litho job can be expensive and take time, but for large print runs it remains the most efficient process and also boasts superior quality and finish.

- Most cost effective for large print runs (500+)
- Unrivaled print quality

SUPPLYING YOUR FILES



*Check with your printer first to make sure you meet all of their requirements when supplying your file.

Usually printers want a PDF file at full print resolution (300 DPI) with no compression. DO NOT send a JPG file, that's weak shit.

PRINTING: DIGITAL VS LITHO

Digital

Digital print presses are essentially very big and very fast color laser printers. They can handle some heavier papers and cards but offer nowhere near as much flexibility as litho print.

- Most cost effective for small print runs
- Print on demand
- Very fast turnaround times

- Drop in print quality
- Less flexibility than litho print
- Can only print up to A3 size

SPELLCHECK



You don't want to be that guy who screws up a huge print job with a typo! Before sending your files to print be sure to hit **⌘F** and make sure everything is spelled correctly.

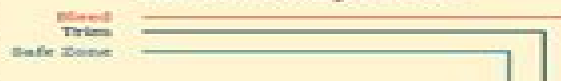
BLEED & TRIM

Bleed

A little space (usually 3 or 5mm) around the edge of your poster design which (depending on how the printer cuts the paper down) may or may not be shown in the finished result. It's essentially your reserve for error and ensures there isn't a random white line on the edges of your poster printing.

Trim

The trim is the edge of the final printed output. To prevent text and logos being chopped off the final output they should be placed with some breathing space around them and no closer to the Trim Edge than 1/8in.



BLACK

= 100% K

This will print more gray than expected. It is good for text, but not for large blocks of black.

= 70%C 50%M 30%Y 100%K

This is a rich black. The four layers of color will make it print as a true black, not gray.

Experiment with your blacks. You can achieve different weights in your blacks by using other percentages of CMY. Blacks will also look different depending on the paper they are printed on.
