- Inspired the Dervish leader, Muhammad Abdullah Hassan to rally support across the Horn of Africa
 - Began the longest colonial resistance
 - Received weapons from Ottomans, Sudan and other Islamic/Arabic countries
- 1920, Dervish state collapsed after considerable aerial bombardment by the English
- England, Italy and France seized territory respectively
