Dialectic Roy Bhaskar, 2008-07-02 *Dialectic: The Pulse of Freedom* is now widely regarded as a classic of contemporary philosophy. This book first published in 1993 sets itself three main aims: the development of a general theory of dialectic of which Hegelian dialectic can be seen to be a special case; the dialectical enrichment and deepening of critical realism; viz into the system of dialectical critical realism and the outline of the elements of a totalizing critique of Western philosophy.
