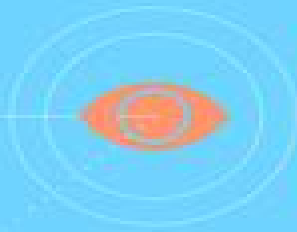

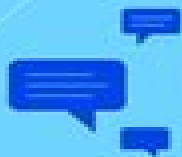
Analysis
