Introduction

- Crisis and trauma are two distinct experiences that challenge individuals to think, react, and behave protectively due to perceptions of real or imagined stress or danger.
- Most of the time, crisis precedes trauma.
- However, if trauma is not effectively resolved, it may act as a springboard for further crises that otherwise would not occur.
- The trauma that is addressed with success will often give an individual a refined ability to better overcome future stressors before a conflict arises to the level of crisis.
- Therefore, effective crisis intervention is essential to minimize the outcome of trauma and long-term crisis vulnerability.
