This book represents a compilation of essays and research reports from prominent researchers and clinicians thinking and working on the cutting edge of a serious national issue—the quality and qualifications of caregivers for preschool-age children. We need far more information on the experiences, workplace contexts, personal strengths, and vulnerabilities of child-care providers. With the increasing prevalence of employed parents requiring child care for children ever younger, even those just a few weeks old, a clearer picture is urgently needed of who the caregivers are, what training and education they have, and how their work impacts child outcomes in terms of children's intellectual and emotional well-being. The writers of these 15 chapters speculate about how dollars should be spent on early childhood education (ECE) training for providers, for assessing the quality of training and of classroom performance, for assessing the relationship between teacher training and child outcomes, and for determining what political measures are necessary to implement
