

the explanations satisfy the cultural needs of the writers (extreme self-promotion and aggrandizement in Raleigh's case, along with multiple untruths designed to obscure the actual events of the voyage). There are the expected differences, particularly of the impact of modernity, and the characteristics of the "New El Dorado," a sad little town scarred by the environmental devastation of uncontrolled mining.

El Dorado is clearly a utopia, a dream of those who seek adventure, wealth, and escape. The appeal of this work is to both scholars in diverse disciplines capable of disassembling the threads of the tapestry for their own purposes and dreamers who would find the mix of myth and reality an intoxicating blend. The book has a marginal utility as a solution to many utopian themes; but has considerable value nonetheless for its intellectual challenge of the endlessly diverse, but essentially the same search for the ideal, the El Dorado of past and present.

Susan M. Nuernberg, *The Critical Response to Jack London*.

AS DEFECTIVE AS IT HAS BEEN in the selection of authors, Greenwood Press's *Critical Responses in Arts and Letters* series has provided scholars with an invaluable resource. Unlike its predecessor, the *Critical Heritage* series, which, despite the importance of its own contribution, limited scholars to the contemporary reviews of distinguished American and British authors, the Greenwood series has taken a more liberal approach on two fronts. First, rather than limit itself to contemporary reviews, the series includes significant contemporary essays about the authors' works. Second, Greenwood's in-house editors wisely decided to expand the range of authors by including writers likely to have been barred from the *Critical Heritage* series. As a result, scholars of the gothic have been blessed with volumes on Bram Stoker and Anne Radcliffe; mystery buffs with those on Raymond Chandler and Dashiell Hammett, and aficionados of southern fiction with those on Fannie Welby and Ann Beattie.

Another group so blessed comprise scholars of naturalism. Since none of America's turn-of-the-century naturalists (with the possible exception of Stephen Crane) has risen high enough in American literary opinion to merit the type of attention bestowed by the *Critical Heritage* series, it is a relief to see the absence of such snubbery in the Greenwood series. For Jack London scholars, the need for a volume of this sort has long been recognized ever since Hensley Woodbridge's bibliography, in which were listed over 400 contemporary reviews of London's plays, essays, novellas, novels, and short story collections. These reviews are difficult to locate despite their importance to London scholars—hard to locate because no press has seen fit to have them collected and printed; important to London scholars because London, as one of America's most popular writers, had so great an impact on his cultural milieu. As Nuernberg herself notes, "Readers are always astonished to discover that, in addition to being one of the most popular and highest paid authors in America during his lifetime (1876-1916), London has been the best-selling American writer in the world. He has been translated more extensively (in over eighty languages) than any other American or English novelist of the twentieth century" (xxiv). Though one cannot vouch for the accuracy of all of the above assertions,
