have come to faith in Messiah but since they are still fettered with the Law, circumcision and the Sabbath and the rest, they are not in accord with Christians. They have the Good News according to Matthew in its entirety in Hebrew. For it is clear they still preserve this in the Hebrew alphabet as it was originally written. Epiphanius Panarion 29 fourth century. Are these Nazarenes actually the unknown continuation of the Apostle Paul's ministry? What about the Jerusalem Church mentioned so frequently by Paul and headed up by Peter and James the Just?
