The volume also contains 16 pages of illustrations, including previously unseen photographs of Ford and Biala and reproductions of Biala's paintings and drawings of Provence.

Since the early 1980s, the winds of global capitalism became stronger. It was a period where developing countries, with their mostly inward-looking and nationalistic policies, suffered deep crisis like the Latin American debt crisis of the early 1980s or the collapse of the Soviet Bloc in 1991. During this era, neoliberal economies of the more developed world built the hegemonic power.
