Felix Seidler, 2009-11-04 Essay from the year 2009 in the subject Politics Political Theory and the History of Ideas Journal grade 73 von 100 Punkten The University of Sydney Center for International Security Studies course New Security Challenges language English abstract This essay deals about the approaches of Critical Security Studies CSS to the the War on Terrorism WoT To understand the approaches of CSS it is important to know that this view has its origin in the critique of the traditional approaches realism and liberalism A consequence of this is CSS do not see the state as most important referent object In contrast to realism and liberalism it is the approach of CSS to look for alternative referent objects beside the state But CSS are not just one approach It is divided into different schools or drifts This essay wants to research how these schools and drifts analyse the WoT Central to this are the paragraphs 2 and 3 which deal about Welsh School and Copenhagen School These two are most important drifts inside CSS The other drifts will be discussed in paragraph 4 Afterwards in paragraph 5 it will be pointed out where the failures and critic points of CSS in general as well as in its drifts are Even if the impacts in its drifts differ CSS is based on the Critical Theory Frankfurt School Habermas and on Poststructuralism Foucault This means on the one hand that CSS does not take the state as the most important referent object but thinks more broadly about the reasons for in security And on the other hand CSS researchers according to Critical Theory claim reality to be socially constructed and want to look behind the empiricist world In context of WoT we will see later that this means a critic on official or governmental standpoints The debates between CSS and governmental or traditional approaches start at the definition of terrorism Definitions of terrorism are broadly discussed in practical politics and in International Relations IR Because this is such a high class topic an own definition will be used in this essay So terrorism shall be defined as an act of political motivated non state violence for achieving a declared aim Of course this definition will be discussed in contrast to the definition CSS researches made From the debates in the public and the media one has of course a general understanding of WoT It can be stated here that WoT is mostly understood as fight of the Western world against the global militant Islamist movement known as Al Qaeda This situation will be important for the further analysis but also a more abstract definition of WoT is necessary here Securitization and the Iraq War Faye Donnelly, 2013-08-15 This book critiques the conceptualization of security found in mainstream and critical theoretical debates and applies this to the empirical case of the 2003 Iraq War The Iraq War represents one of the most puzzling complex and controversial events in the post Cold War era The manner in which the Bush administration finally decided to hold Saddam Hussein accountable through military intervention provoked a worldwide outcry due to the narratives they constructed to justify the pre emptive use of force and enhanced interrogation techniques Responding to constructivist and post structuralist scholars calls for a turn to discourse and aligning its argument with critical security studies particularly the Copenhagen School CS this book conceptualizes language as a pivotal mechanism of power Adopting a Wittgensteinian approach it moves away from thinking about the nexus between security and language from a single action or speech act to a

series of actions or interactions To illustrate this new approach the author examines two cases in particular the UN inspectors finding that there was no credible evidence that Iraq possessed weapons of mass destruction WMD in early 2003 and the Abu Ghraib scandal in 2004 Both events show that the boundaries and relations between securitized rules and environments are not pre given but produced in a particular language game This book will be of much interest to students of critical security studies US foreign policy and IR in general
