THE CRITIQUE OF DOMINATION. By Trent Schroyer. New York: George Braziller and Company. 1973.

Too many social scientists assume that what constitutes knowledge and how it is used are other people's business. Many orthodox sociologists, for instance, have taken Durkheim's statement that social facts should be treated "comme des choses" and Weber's separation of scientific from value-related activity as limiting them to the objectification of social phenomena as data to be manipulated for purely scientific purposes. In recent years their value-neutral objectivism has been criticized by ethnomethodologists and phenomenologists and the challenge of various forms of Marxism continues, particularly that of contemporary representatives of the Frankfurt School like Habermas and Wellmer, whose work Schroyer aims to extend and develop. As what is probably the first detailed attempt by someone whose mother-tongue is English to contribute to the development of Critical Theory, the book has considerable merit.

Critical Theory is needed, he says, as a means to restore sanity to the contemporary world, dominated as it is by (mainly American) "administrative systems and control technologies for the 'stabilization' of international and domestic 'social problems'." Social Science serves this structure by taking for granted existing institutions rather than studying possible alternatives. Emancipation will come about only if existing constraints are demystified and the "possibilities of an advanced civilization" are used to grant people more autonomy in the areas of production and leisure and greater authenticity in human relationships. Schroyer prefers decentralized communitarianism to the dictatorial regimes that have been produced by socialist revolutions. His outlook is romantic and utopian. But that is not to say that it does not present real possibilities.

He traces the origins of the concept of alienation to Christian dualism and to the resolution in Medieval and Rennaissance discussions of Greek ambivalences about
