DEFINITION

SDT looks at how humans make a decision based on the strength of a signal and their confidence of what they heard. According to Kelly and Hahn (2019), SDT "is used when psychologists want to measure the way we make decisions under conditions of uncertainty, such as how we would perceive distances in foggy conditions" (p. 159).

OUTCOMES

Signal detection theory (SDT) predicts four possible outcomes that can occur in a detection task, depending on whether the observer responds "yes" or "no" to the presence of a signal. These outcomes are:

- Hit
- Miss
- False alarm
- Correct rejection

Diagnostic accuracy in a wide range of tasks can be expressed in terms of the ROC area index. Choosing the appropriate decision criterion for a given diagnostic setting, rather than considering some single criterion to be natural and fixed, has a major impact on the efficacy of a diagnostic process or system. Illustrated here by separate chapters are diagnostic systems in radiology, information retrieval, aptitude testing, survey research, and environments in which imminent dangerous conditions must be detected. Data from weather forecasting, blood testing, and polygraph lie detection are also reported. One of these
