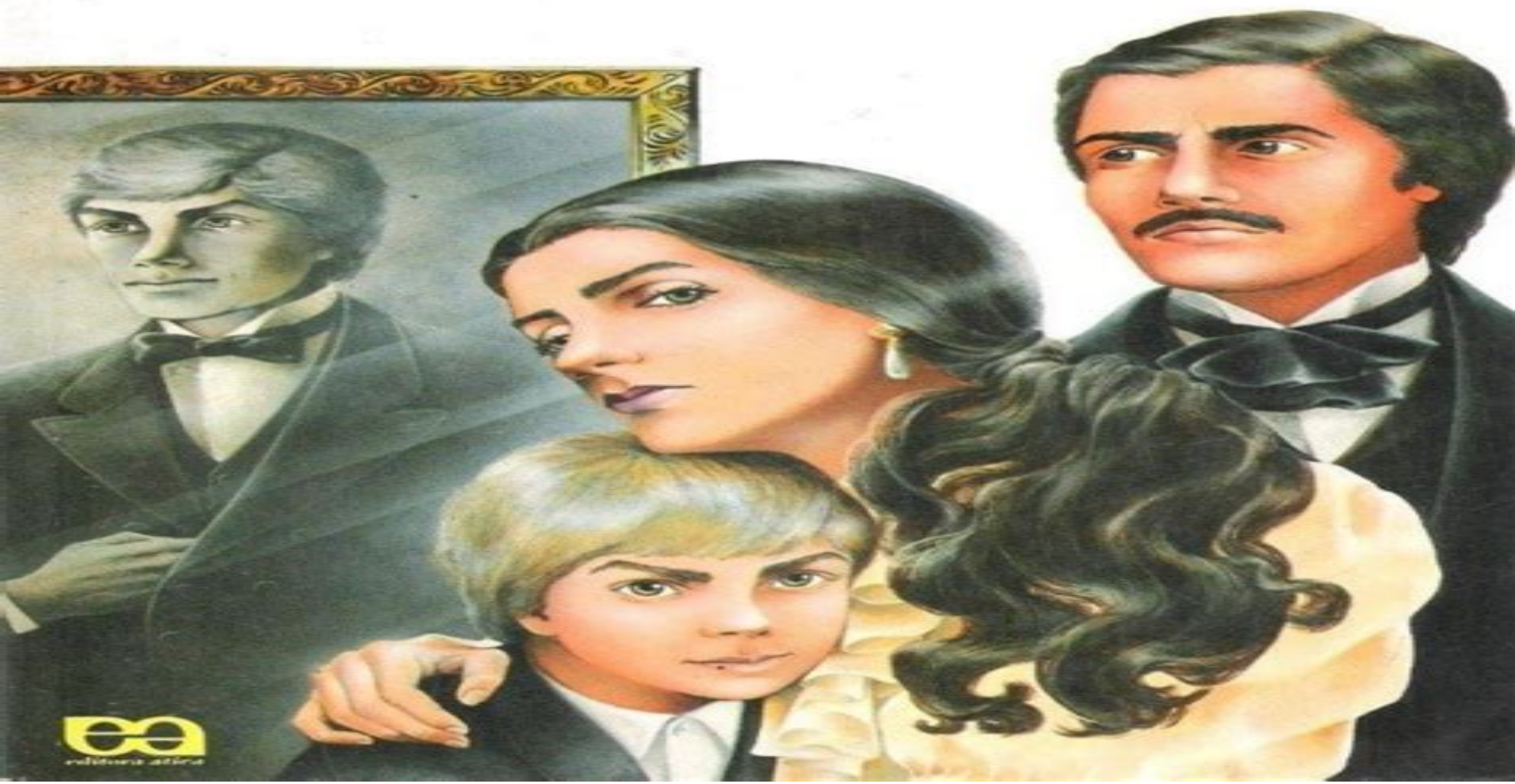

The concluding chapter, summing up the main strands of the argument, points out that the habits of thought which govern the narration are also those which govern the class and society to which Bento belongs. The argument throughout is supported by extensive quotations from the Portuguese, with English translation. This study of Dom Casmurro lays the basis for a more realistic and comprehensive understanding of a major novelist. It has important implications for the general study of the late nineteenth century and early twentieth century novel, as well as for the history of Brazilian and Latin American literature.
