This option involves the use of hormone injections to stimulate the ovaries and course or regulate ovalation.

OVARIAN STIMULATION

A) Stimulation

The ovaries are stimulated with medication to promote the growth of folloles containing the eggs.

B) Control

The response of the owaries is monitored with ultrasounds and/or blood tests, to control the size and quantity of follicles.

C) Egg release

To assist with the final maturation of the egg and lootening of the egg from the foliale wall, an injection of Human Chorionic Gonadotrophin (hCG) - the trigger - is administered.

D) Sperm

Using donor sperm - frozen sperm

Sperm sample is obtained from either a:

- Recipient recruited donor (known donor)
- Clinic-recruited donor (unknown donor).





E) Sperm selection

The froben donor sperm is thawed and washed, and the live mobile sperm are selected for intermination.

F) Insemination

The final sperm preparation is gently inserted into the uterine cavity using a speculum and a disposable catheter to bypass the cervis.
