Derrida s critique of binary oppositions such as presence absence speech writing and truth falsehood argued that these pairs are not neutral but are hierarchically structured with one term always subordinating the other Through works like De la grammatologie 1967 and La Voie et le Voice 1967 Derrida redefined how we understand texts insisting that they are always open to multiple interpretations
