Its 600 illustrations include comprehensive archival photography including Ellwood's own pictures and others by Julius Shulman, original drawings and for those buildings that remain in good condition, recent images. Due to the loss of most of the original drawings, 80 floor plans have been redrawn for this publication, making this book as close a record of Ellwood's complete works as is possible today. His early career was accelerated by producing three projects for Arts Architecture: designing Case Study Houses 16, 17, and 18. His firm and the size of projects they produced grew from small private homes to large commercial, civic, and educational buildings before closing in 1977. The title of this book, based on Jacks' unpublished manuscript *The Thin Man: Remembering Craig Ellwood* written between 1999-2008, recalls
