Causality, Determinism and Prognosis in Criminology. By Jozsef VIGH. Budapest, Hungary: Akadémiai Kiadó, 1986. Pp. 301. DM 59.00 (hardbound).

The author presents a social science perspective on the causation and treatment of crime. Although there is little reference to the legal system or codes of Hungary, this book was sent to the publishers for publication in Hungarian in 1977. The purpose of the study was to provide a theoretical background for the Hungarian Penal Code which was implemented on July 1st, 1979 (p. 15).

Drawing on literature from many different disciplines, Vigh's analysis is a blend of western and Soviet research on the etiology of criminality. For those already familiar with socialist and western European criminological literature there will be little that is new or surprising. But the author provides a carefully thought out synthesis of a wide range of material. Furthermore, his concluding section on the treatment of the offender in Hungary provides some interesting and valuable data that supports his analysis.

Those familiar with the study *Prichinnost' v kriminologii* (Causality in Criminology) by the leading Soviet criminologist V. N. Kudriavtsev will find much that is reminiscent in Vigh's work. Vigh, like Kudriavtsev, tries to show that there are no simple explanations of crime. Crime is not caused solely by economic conditions but results from the complex interaction of the individual with his environment. As in Kudriavstev's study complex schemata are provided to explain the impact of past events and present conditions on the likelihood of crime commission.

Vigh suggests that those who are most likely to commit crime are individuals who have no long range plans in life (p. 91). Like some Western criminologists, he concludes that most offenders are present oriented. Furthermore, Vigh suggests they do not conscientiously choose to be criminals but are individuals who are so selfish that they consistently place their interests before those of the larger society. He supports the findings of other socialist scholars that the criminal is antisocial in nature. Although Vigh makes some allowance for biological factors, he does
