1900: THE ETERNALLY YOUNG EMPIRE

A Story of the Year 2200

By Robert William Coile, is considered by some the first true space opera. The novel characterizes an interstellar conflict between Earth and a fictional nation torn in the new cosmic battle. It is one of the first of novels to combine the concepts of galactic empires, interstellar travel, and spaceships in the thousands, doing battle in deep space.

1901: A HONEYMOON IN SPACE

George Griffith

A highly popular series, actually consisting of contemporary H.G. Wells in England, but unfortunately all but forgotten today except by a handful of historians. He was not popular in the US due to some of his novels having anti-American themes. Still, in 1901 he published a short story collection titled *A Honeymoon in Space*. It was based on a series of stories published in *Astounding's* magazine called "Stories of Other Worlds," and is considered the blueprint for space opera as we know it. The series followed a pair of scientists who set out to colonize the solar system in a spaceship called the "Arcturion." They started at the Moon, then off to Venus, then and the rest of the outer planets (except Pluto, which at the time was still 30 years from discovery).

1901: TARIANO AND THE CONQUEST

Ray Cummings

A popular serial in *Science and Speculation* (July 1927 - Aug. 1928). Once an immensely successful in the capital of Venus, young Tariano was hungry for power. He believed an army, composed Venus, then Earth, and on for rights on the rest of the solar system.

1910: THE MYSTERY OF SPACE

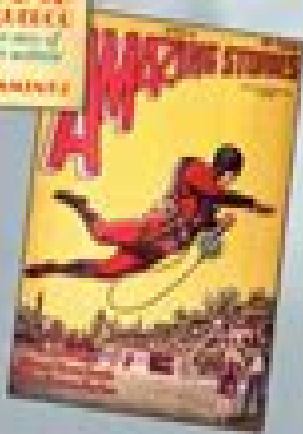
Edward L. Smith

The novel *Mystery of Space* presented in *Amazing Stories* in four parts (Aug. - Oct. 1910). It is considered the first true space opera novel, by the man who would be crowned the "Father of Space Fiction." Interstellar travel, electronic spaceships, alien planets, and conflict were all found in this series of four novels.

1910: MEY & ROBERTS

Philip Francis Nowlan

One of the most important names in space opera was introduced upon the id world in a story titled, "Annapolis 2419 A.D." This story was by great coincidence published at the same time in the same issue as *The Mystery of Space*, in the August 1910 issue of *Amazing Stories*. This one tale would give birth to a long running comic strip, a series and radio serials. There are three television series.



Literature Through the 20th Century

1910: THE LEWMAN series

E.E. "Doc" Smith

Smith was back with another series, an even greater scale than his *Robot* novels. This collection of six novels focuses on the exploits of an intergalactic police force known as the *Leumans*. The series comes from a powerful "best" which they were on their series, giving them intergalactic power. It was a runner-up for the 1960 Hugo award for Best All-Time Series, finally losing to Isaac Asimov's *Foundation* series.

1910: THE LEGION OF SPACE

Jack Williamson

The *Legion of Space* was the first novel and began as a six-part serialization in *Amazing Stories* (Apr. - Sept. 1910). Earth has colonized the entire solar system and the *Legion* is a military police force which protects it. In particular, the *Legion* must guard the female descendants of a family who are keepers of the secret to an ultimate weapon known as A.R.K.A. It is not long before the very existence of humanity is challenged by something which the readers know as the "Machine."

1910: FLAME GARDEN

Inspired by the success of *Flash Gordon*, the *Flame Garden* comic strip premiered on Jan. 7, 1914, by entering syndication exactly five years after the premiere of the *Flash Gordon* comic strip on Jan. 7, 1909. It was followed by a 26-part weekly radio serial which launched on Apr. 22, 1915 as *The Amazing Interplanetary Adventures of Flame Garden*. This was then followed by a second radio series which was the 10 episodes and finally a trio of three serials: *Flame Garden* (1916), *Flame Garden's Trip to Mars* (1916), and *Flame Garden's Conquest of the Universe* (1916). Much more would develop in the years to come.

1910: COSMIC ENGINEERS

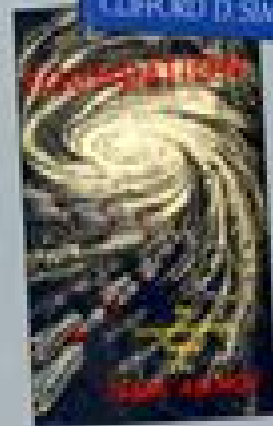
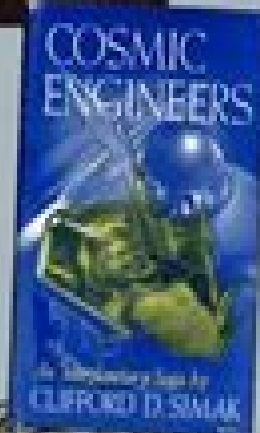
Clifford D. Simak

The *Miles Way* is on a collision course with another galaxy. Meanwhile, in the other galaxy, an ancient civilization has been reconstructing a distant capital representing help. Several interstellar races respond to the call including Earth. Fighting through time and space, a team called the Cosmic Engineers work to meet the threat.

1910: THE FOUNDATION TRILOGY

Isaac Asimov

This began as a series of eight short stories, published in *Amazing Stories* (1942 - 1950) and eventually collected in book form. The story of a galactic empire that is doomed to fall, and one scientist's efforts to make the inevitable dark ages from stretching 50,000 years to a mere 1,000 years of life is successful.
