Data was analyzed using NVivo and CMap which formulated the following emergent themes: teacher and student development, fostering and enriching classroom and school community, Aha! moments, the TB experience and insights into a teacher friendly TB manual. Recommendations for research and practice were considered and presented for researchers and educators.
