JANE is a woman in her early 40s whose life has been physically and emotionally challenging. She has undergone 14 surgeries, has 17 different medical diagnoses, has been prescribed over 50 different medications, and has developed allergies to seven others. She has had CT and MRI scans as well as a myelogram and a

colonoscopy. She reports that she has been physically and sexually abused by several members of her family, including her mother. Her experience with husbands has been no less disastrous. She was battered by her first husband, and abandoned by her second; her third, a young man from a Middle-Eastern country, treated her with disdain before eventually leaving her. Her son, now in his early 20s, has a knack for irresponsible behavior, the latest example of which has been fathering a daughter whom he has since abandoned. It comes as no surprise that Jane has posed a challenge to our health care system. Beginning in 1992, Jane has been the catalyst for and focus of a loosely knit team of practitioners that has worked collaboratively to provide her with coordinated and comprehensive health care.

Since 1985, Jane has received her medical care from the Group Health Cooperative of Puget Sound, a large HMO serving Washington State. Her physical suffering can be measured in pounds. Jane's medical charts, located at GHC's Lynwood Medical Clinic, now number three, with each of the first two weighing over five pounds, a testament to her relief-seeking tenacity. Her mental health folder, located at GHC's Eastside Mental Health Services Clinic (23 miles south of Lynnwood) weighs in at under five pounds, a testament to both
