Collocation derives from the Latin *collocare* meaning *place together*. It refers to items in the language which are conventionally found together, placed that way, in other words.

Collocation can be defined as "a familiar grouping of words, especially words that habitually appear together and thereby convey meaning by association:

examples: 'pass' and 'make'

'roasted meat' and 'toasted bread'

When words are used regularly, rules are formed about their use not for grammatical reasons.
