differences that we have had in the past and continue to have in more pronounced ways at present Rist uses both sociological and anthropological methods to examine life in one segregated African American school in the mid western United States A classroom of some thirty children were followed from their first day of kindergarten through the second grade Detailed accounts of the day by day process of sorting stratifying and separating the children by social class backgrounds demonstrates the means of ensuring that both the poor and middle class students soon learned their appropriate place in the social hierarchy of the school Instructional time discipline and teacher attention all varied by social class of the students with those at the bottom of the ladder consistently receiving few positive rewards and many negative sanctions When The Urban School was first published in 1973 the National School Boards Association called it one of the ten most influential books on American education for the year It remains essential reading for educators sociologists and economists
