3. Identify Alternatives

Start brainstorming and listing all possible solutions & then evaluate the validity of each option.



4. Consider the Evidence

Now carefully consider all of the options, such as by doing a SWOT analysis on each.



5. Choose the Best Option

Now it's time to choose the best option from the solutions you listed.



6. Time for Action

Make a detailed plan to action the decision. Include such things as resources and full planning.



7. Reviewing

After the decision has been actioned, review the outcome and learn from any mistakes.
