Fleming, 2012 The schizophrenia syndrome was developed with the aim of distinguishing between those people that have the syndrome and those people that do not and between those people with the syndrome and those people with other distinct syndromes The basis for syndromes to be recognised is that they are made up of symptoms unique to that syndrome and that the pattern between those symptoms determines onset course and prognosis Valid syndromes are then used to identify the disease agent that causes these symptoms to occur and vary together Once a disease agent is identified it is possible to develop treatments that eliminate the disease agent In the hundred years since its development the schizophrenia syndrome has failed to deliver these expected outcomes Problems remain regarding reliability of diagnosis
