human life to survive in every location upon it naturally with the exception of Antarctica Remember one thing from the first time you boiled water salt water freezes at a lower temperature and boils at a lower temperature This means salt water evaporates at a lower temperature If the oceans were all fresh water there would be a lot less water vapor in the air and less rain In order to have more water vapor in a world with freshwater oceans you would need more of it to be exposed to the sun which means more of the planet would need to be water It seems we have just the right balance of salt water and salinity of that salt water to make rain and just the right balance of freshwater to survive The Earth might well roll around on its axis but for a single large moon to stabilize its orbit and provide tidal changes If the oceans had been bigger the tidal effect would have been greater and much of the life that relies on tides would not exist The Earth has an atmosphere that protects us from radiation and keeps
